like in practice?

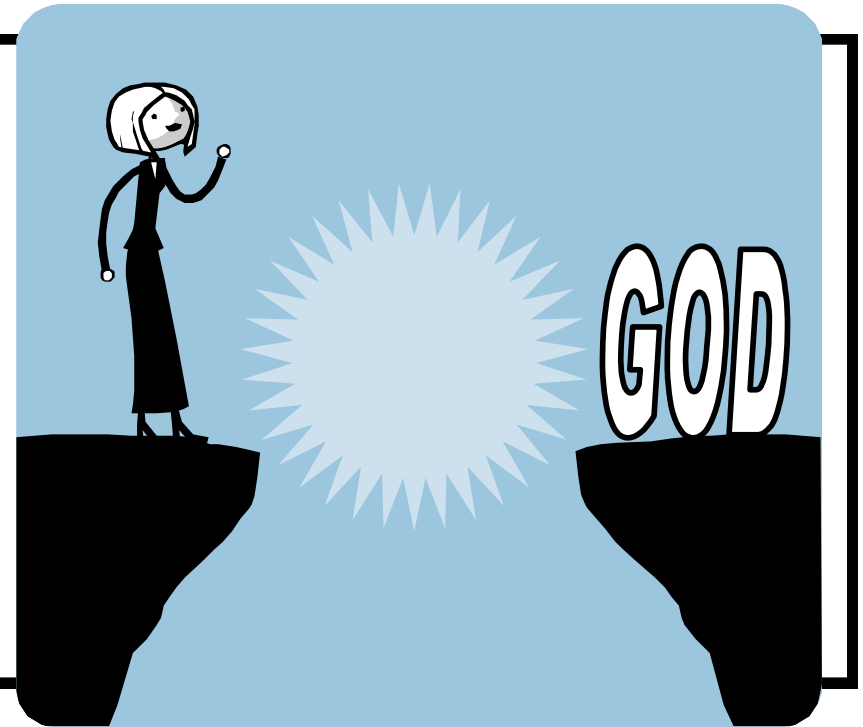


Sin is disobeying God and not

when they sinned?

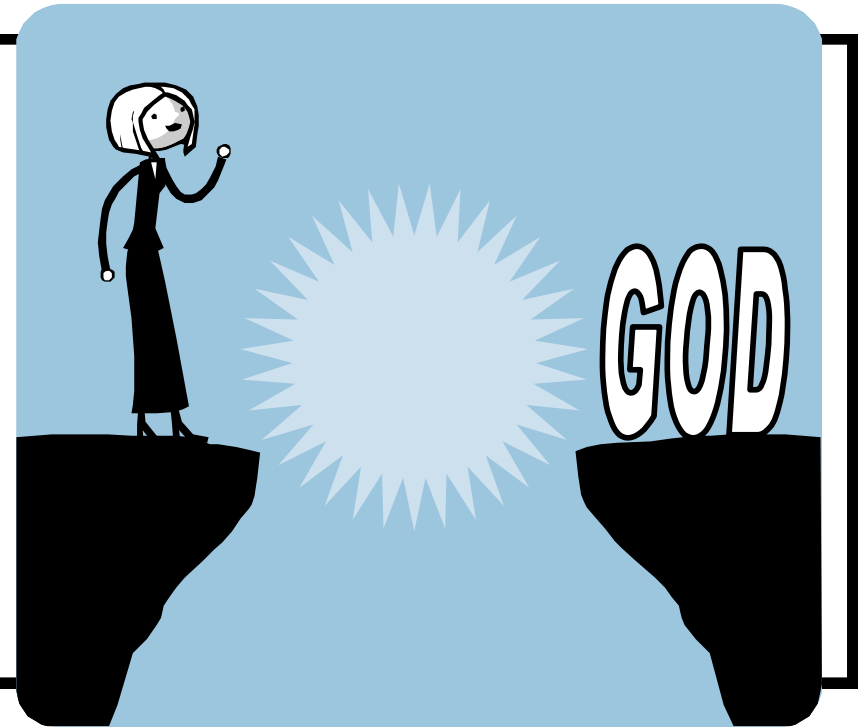


They were separated from God.

affect us?

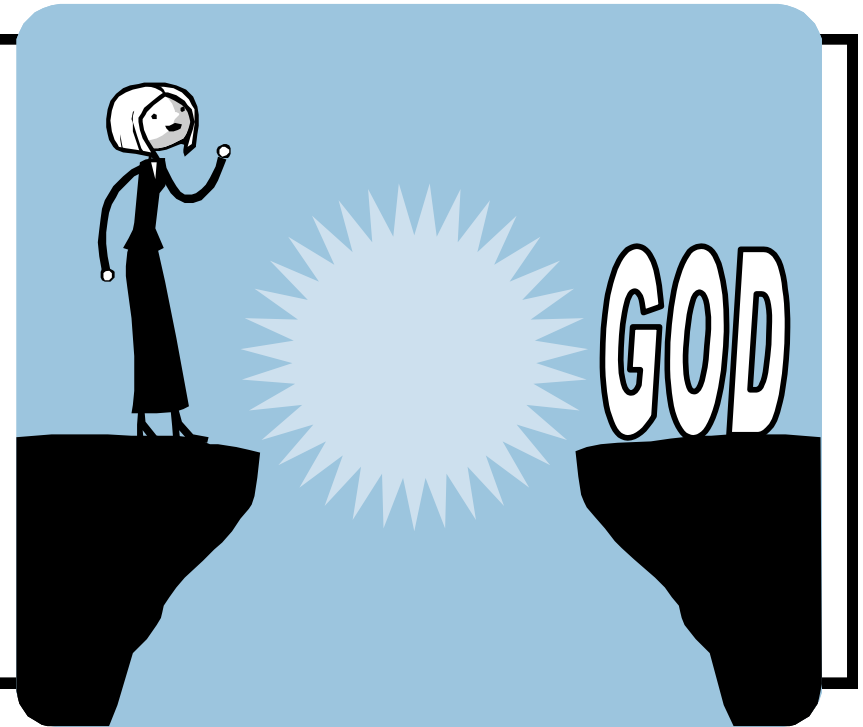


Yes. We are all Adam's children.

sin deserve?

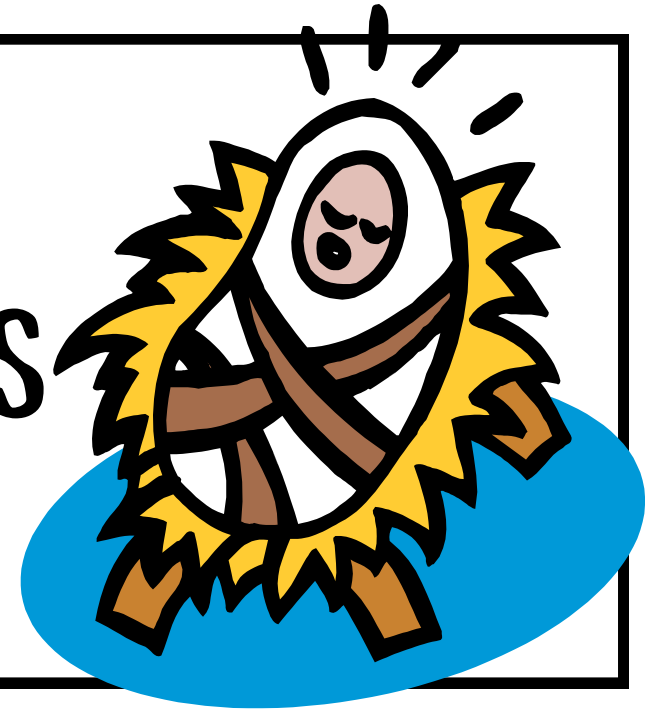


God's anger and punishment.

anger and punishment?

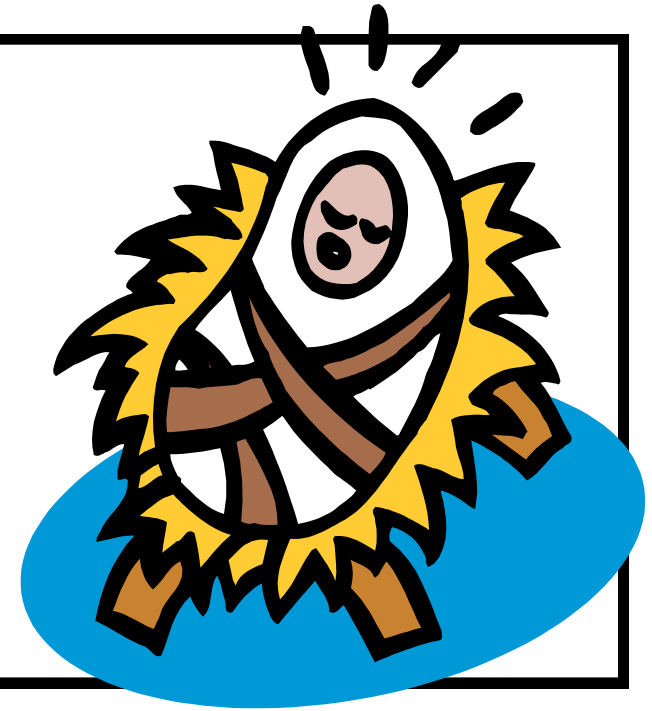


He sent his Son.

Who is God's Son?

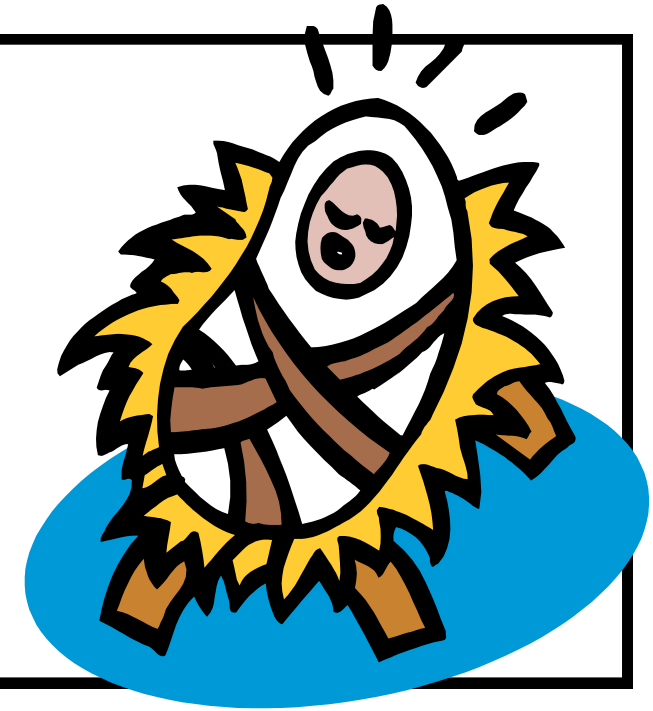


The Lord Jesus Christ.

into this world?

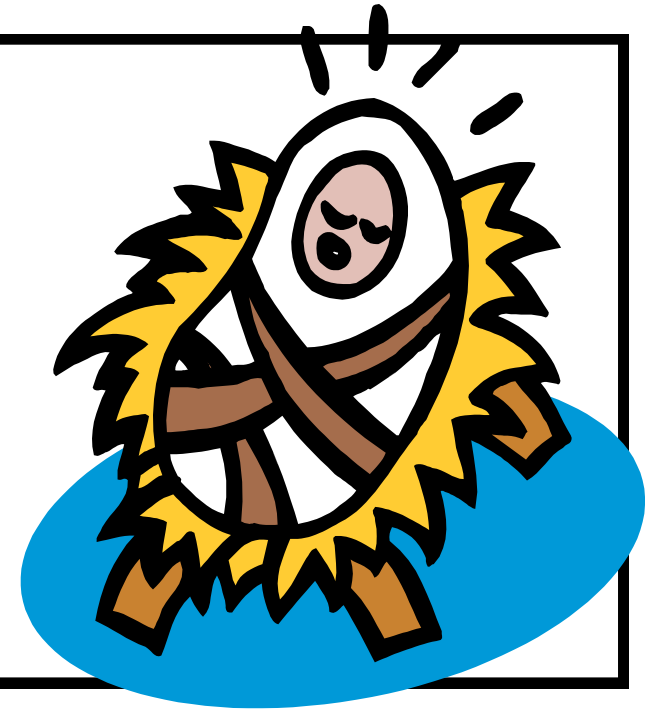


He was born as a baby in

Did Jesus ever sin?

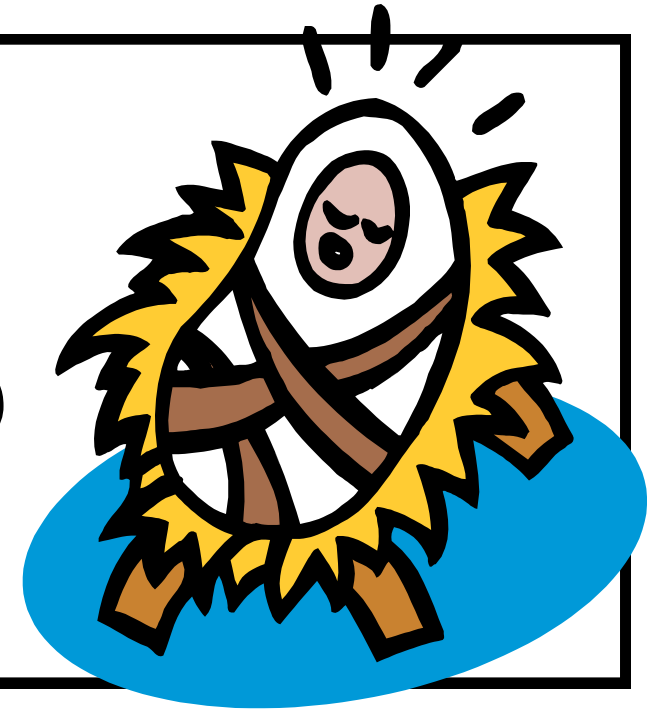


No. He always loved and

die for?

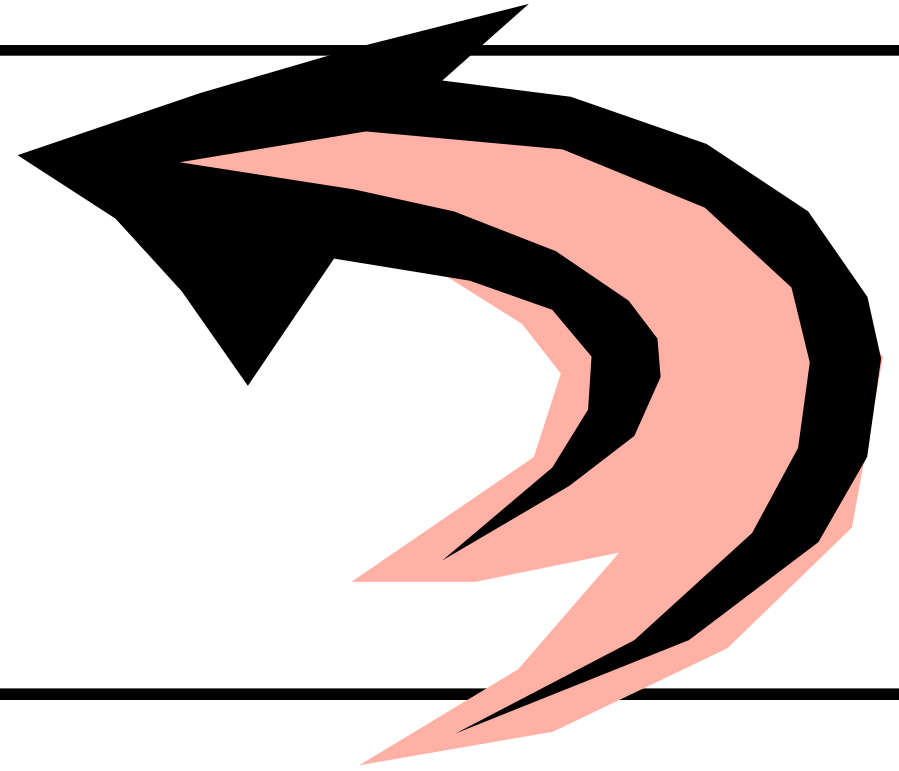


For all the people God the Father

saved?

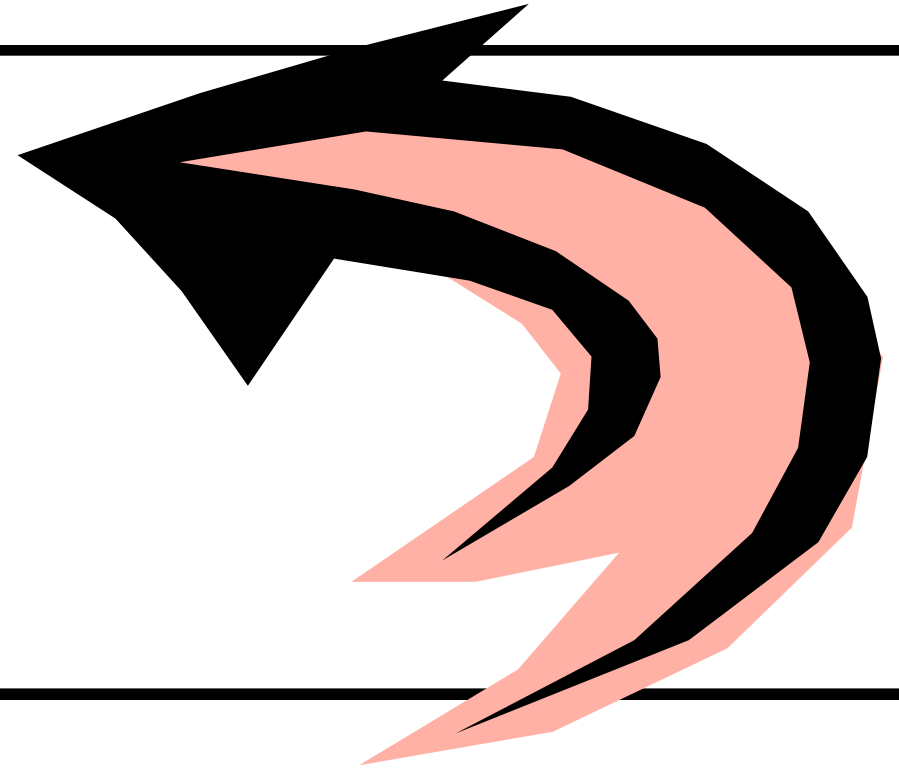


Only those who repent of their
