## WOODGREEN COMMUNITY AGREEMENT (Covid-19) v6

It is requested that all members of the Woodgreen Church community who attend the 'Sundays AM' services should lovingly look out for the safety of all present by adhering to the provisions contained in this agreement\*.

We appreciate that these measures make it harder to be the friendly, welcoming and relational church family we aspire to be, but in these challenging times it is vital that we should comply fully with the Government's guidelines, playing our part in the national and local effort to contain the pandemic, and being a good witness and loving neighbour to our local community.

Please **co-operate fully with the Duty Team** who are there to ensure that everything is as safe as possible.

- Please bring your own Bible. The Bible readings will also be projected onto the screens.
- Please bring your own bottled water there will be no provision of cold water.
   Refreshments are served, outdoors, after each service.
- Please **do not bring cash gifts** please contact the church office for information about how to give in a 'cashless' way.
- When you arrive, if there is a long queue please wait in your car until the queue goes down a little. Queue at 2m intervals between household groups/'bubbles'.
- Upon entering the front of the building, please sanitise your hands thoroughly at one of the sanitising stations. Please avoid touching any surfaces.
- Make your way quickly and efficiently to your allocated seats, as sent to you with the seating plan. If unsure, a member of the Duty Team will help you in a socially distanced way.
- Inside, please wait until you are seated and restrict conversation to those seated around you. Please do not 'mingle' or hold conversations when standing up.
- When talking or responding during a service, please speak at a 'normal' level, avoiding raising your voice at any time. Please do not sing (sorry!).
- At the conclusion of the meeting you will be asked, by a service leader, to leave in an
  orderly and organised way. Please make your way out through the front fire exit or the
  rear fire doors onto the lawned area. When outside of the building please maintain a
  social distance when conversing with others.
- If at all possible, please avoid using toilets. If it is absolutely necessary, wait for an attendant member of the Duty Team to indicate when it is appropriate to go in there will be a 'one in, one out system'. Please adhere to the concise instructions displayed in the toilets. Tissues are available throughout the building. Please contain coughs and sneezes!

It is mandatory by law for all attendees age eleven and older to wear a face covering to these meetings - unless they have a physical or medical reason not to (see Government Guidance on wearing face coverings).

Anyone who is symptomatic, or who is in a household with someone who is symptomatic should not attend and should follow Government guidance.
